

These Agents Testifie that Chaque the sachem of Pacomtuck for good & valuable Considerations him thereunto moving, hath given, granted, Bargained & sold, & by these Agents Doth for himselfe & his Brother Napahoale, fully, clearly & absolutely give, grant, Bargaine & sell unto Capt John Dymochon of Springfield for the use & behoofe of Major Eleazer Lusher, & Squire Dant ffisher & their English of Dedham, their Associates, & successours, & to them & their heires for ever, Certaine p[ar]ts of Land at Pacomtuck on the further side or opp[os]ite or North side of Pacomtuck River, that is to say beginning aboves, where the Puckomegon river runs into Pacomtuck River, & so a little way up Puckomegon River, & then leading Puckomegon away, runs off to the Sunnyside westward: All the land betwixt the Sunnyside on the westward, & downe the River Pacomtuck eastward below Nayyocossick to Poche wee meete the mouth of Puckomegon river; each p[ar]ts of Land are called Nayyocossick, Tomholissick, Massgomcossick, Wssowack, Wuyquawawag & so to Sunnyside hill, or by what ever other names the Land is or maybe called: All the aforedescrib'd Tract of Land, being called by severall names as aforesaid viz Nayyocossick, Tomholissick, Massgomcossick, Wssowack, Wuyquawawag & Sunnyside, or by what ever other names it maybe called, Together with the Trees, woods, meadows, roads, Brooks, upland, Stones, & Commodities & advantage thereof & whatsoever belonging or in any way appertaining, the aforesaid Major Eleazer Lusher & Squire Dant ffisher of Dedham, their Associates, & successours, & their Heires are to have, hold & enjoy, & their goods, only the said Chaque doth reserve Liberty of fishing for the Indians in the River, or waters, & free Liberty to hunt deer or other wild creatures, & to gather walnuts, chestnuts & other things on the Commons: And the said Chaque doth hereby Covenant & comitt to & with the said Major Eleazer Lusher & Squire Dant ffisher, that he will with Saul the said Major Lusher & Dant ffisher, their Associates, & their Heires & assigns, & assigns of & defend all manner of claimes of any person or persons lawfully claiming any right Title or interest in any of the Land hereby sold or in any part or p[ar]t thereof, & will defend the same from any molestation or interruption by Indians otherwise than as before expressed, In witness whereof the said Chaque hath hereunto set his hand this 24<sup>th</sup> of febr 1665
